Short description of the workshop (EN)	<p>In this workshop, you will learn what Open Educational Resources (OER) are and how you can integrate them into (re)designing your courses. With the support of didactics experts & information specialists, you will move beyond traditional textbooks and focus on the possibilities of OER. At the same time, you will explore why it can be difficult to use OER and how the university can facilitate teachers in this process. We ask you to choose one of the courses you teach and redesign a small part of it by embedding relevant OER. During the workshop, time and support staff will be available to help you start with the redesign process. On the second day, the participants will share the ideas they came up with for their own courses.</p>
