

### WHAT IS AN EDUBADGE?



#### An award for successfully attaining learning outcomes

An edubadge enables students or workers to show that they have achieved a certain set of knowledge or skills during a period of formal accredited education or during a period of non-formal learning.



#### A single platform for Dutch education

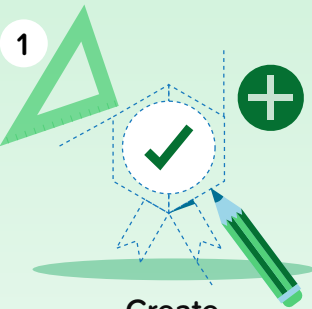
An edubadge is issued in an online format within a secure, trusted platform. The national platform makes it possible to compare, exchange and combine edubadges.



#### Lifelong learning

The knowledge and skills that a student or worker has acquired will be visible in their personal backpack, where they can collect their edubadges. An edubadge can be shared with and verified by employers or learning institutions.

### HOW DOES IT WORK?



#### Create

Each institution can devise and develop its own edubadges. It can then involve teachers and students.



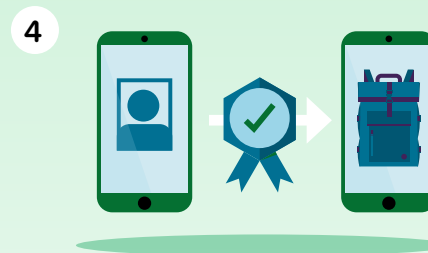
#### Apply

A student can apply for an edubadge online.



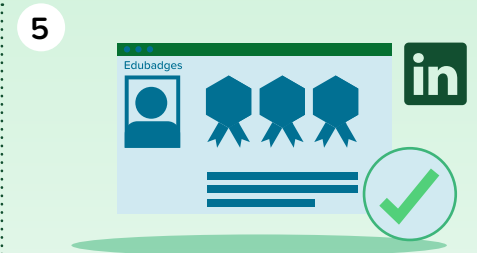
#### Issue

The teacher or administrative staff then assesses the application. The edubadge will be issued if the student meets the criteria.



#### Share

When the student receives an edubadge, they save it in their personal edubadges backpack, where they can share it digitally with employers or other institutions.



#### Verify

External parties, such as employers and institutions, can view any edubadge that has been shared with them and verify its authenticity.
