Functional and technical target architecture for federated infrastructure for research data	Organisation of a vision for research data, with existing and/or future services of members, research communities, market players and/or SURF, including the (continued) development of projects supported by the RDM steering group, such as expertise on the integrated Rule-Oriented Data System (iRODS)	PM
5.2. Organisation of parts of federated infrastructure for research data in coordination with the RDM steering group/expert group	Components that further expand the ecosystem of data services in the Netherlands and Europe, for example the connection of the members and EOSC, and joint de-identification of privacy-sensitive data	PM
5.3. Connection and support	The combination and optimisation of existing RDM knowledge sharing initiatives. Use of the concept of the National Coordination Point for Research Data Management to achieve broader support	PM
