
Sharing learning resources

Educational institutions make various collections of Dutch and English learning resources available. By adopting a Creative Commons licence, the creator of the work gives their permission for the resources to be shared freely and for others to use them in their own teaching practice.



Collaboration in professional communities

edusources facilitates the convenient exchange of learning resources among professional lecturers. This creates an up-to-date collection that helps raise the quality of learning resources. The resources can be shared either entirely openly or only within an institution or professional community.



Inspiration from the professional field

Lecturers and students are able to search the collections of professional communities for learning resources relevant to their discipline. Resources can be shared among peers using social media or a direct link.

HOW DOES IT WORK?




Filters, such as educational level, language and type of learning resource allow you to search quickly and easily.



Lecturers and students choose the learning resources they need for their teaching practice or study.



Users help to judge the quality of the resources by applauding using the clap button or by giving a star rating. The level of appreciation given by others is visible to everyone.



Lecturers or education support staff can upload and share their own resources. Institutional libraries provide support by checking the copyright status of the learning resources and by ensuring the metadata provided is correct.
