What has the NREN community done?




- In 2016 GÉANT tendered the first laaS agreements
 - Mandated by all NRENS to tender on their behalf
 - 14 framework agreements were awarded
 - Frameworks expired on 31 December 2020
- 2020 IaaS+ tender was launched Under the OCRE project
 - GÉANT mandated by NREN's to tender on their behalf
 - Eacht country = 1 lot. -> suppliers dedicated
 - ~ 1150 proposal received / 473 framwork agreements awarded (avg. 14 different Cloud platforms available per country).



- 1. GÉANT mandated by the NREN's as CPB
- 2. CPB = Central Purchasing Body
- 3. GÉANT Tendered as CPB -> Dutch public procurement legislation (for all involved)
- 4. Published on TED






Number of countries using the 2016 and 2020 IaaS Frameworks


Countries using the 2016 and 2020 IaaS Frameworks

28 countries as at 31/12/2023



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
How is OCRE doing?

950 institutions as at 31/12/2023






Annual consumption using the 2016 and 2020 laaS Frameworks

OCRE 2024 Scope, contracts, Lots



- Scope: laaS+
- Contracts: Frameworks now under Dutch law – CoC under local law
- 1 Lot per country
- Sublots per platform
- Max 3 suppliers per sub-lot
- Expected total contract value* 1+ B Euro
- 5 years duration
- Customisation per NREN
- Hybrid approach
- No obligation to procure



Overall aim

- A framework that will make it easy for Customers to consume IaaS+ services in a manner compliant with European procurement legislation and with the best conditions of use. And a direct route for Economic Operators is provided to more easily and efficiently reach and deliver their IaaS+ services to Customers
- Suppliers offer an IaaS+ feature set which matches the Customers' needs
- Customers get access to a broad range of services fitting their needs from multiple Suppliers
- Data is handled safely, secure and Suppliers meet European and National regulations
- Services can be acquired and used through the Customers' purchasing and management structures (such as accepting Purchase Orders and post pay billing)
- Services are connected to and compatible with the Customer's network and Identity Management capabilities







Highlights on market feedback on PIN

- Importance of professional services
- Overall acceptance of the lot structure
- Focus on sustainability
- Clear description and standardization of CRF – NREN activities
- Overall acceptance of 5 years duration of the FW
- Price increases inline with agreed inflation measures
- Undesirable egress costs
- Different positions on minimum discount
- Role NREN as impartial and trusted advisor undisputed
